Supervisor Herrington called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. and instructed the Town Clerk to read the Notice of Public Hearing. The notice had been published in the Troy Record and posted at Town Hall and on the Town website.

The hearing concerned the 2015 Town of Brunswick Preliminary Budget.

Town Bookkeeper/Assistant to Supervisor Patrick Poletto gave an overview of the Preliminary Budget.

VISITORS WHO WISH TO SPEAK:

Mrs. Marie Stasiak, 216 Bulson Rd., President, Board of Trustees of the Brunswick Community Library, thanked the Town Board for their previous support and outlined how the budget for the library is funded and utilized, noting that it is a “break even” scenario. With all around costs rising, she asked the board to consider a modest increase in its yearly stipend, to be used for materials and programs made available to the public.
