RECYCLING CENTER DISPOSAL FEES

| ITEM | FEE | ACTION |

| Garbage Trash Bags* | \$2 Small Bag, \$3 Large Bag | Purchase bag and deliver to Town |
| Small Appliances | \$5 | Deliver to Center |
| Air Conditioners/Hot Water Tank | \$10 | Deliver to Center |
| Large Appliances | \$15 | Deliver to Center |
| Large Appliances at curb** | \$25 | Curbside Pickup |
| Television/Computer Monitors | \$15 | Deliver to Center |
| Un-mounted Passenger Tires | \$2 | Deliver to Center |
| Large Truck Tires | \$10 | Deliver to Center |
| Small Propane Tanks | \$5 | Deliver to Center |

The Town of Brunswick Recycling center has to charge these nominal fees because of the additional cost to the Town to handle and process these items or has to pay a fee to have items such as electron waste to be picked up for legal disposal at approved recycling centers.

RECYCLABLES ACCEPTED FREE OF CHARGE

| ITEM | RECYCLABLE | NOT RECYCLABLE |

| GLASS | Clear, green & amber glass from bottles & jars. Rinse clean & remove caps & lids. Fluorescent & CFL bulbs. | No window glass, auto glass, glass ovenware, ceramic dishware & cookware, Pyrex, clay pots, ornaments or crystal. |
| PLASTIC | Any plastic container that does not break when crushed. Any plastics with the recycling logo & the numbers 1, 2, or 3. | No Styrofoam, pool liners or articles without the recycle logo. No pesticide, herbicide, solvent, oil or paint containers. |
| METAL | Aluminum, steel and tin food or beverage containers. Rinse clean and, if possible, flatten. | No aerosol cans or containers having toxic residues such as chemicals, pesticides, herbicides, oil, gas or paint. No propane tanks. No pie plates. |
| PAPER & CARDBOARD | Catalogs, newspapers, magazines, junk mail, paper bags and books. Must be clean. Pizza boxes OK. | No soiled paper such as that used for painting or animal waste. Remove wire bindings, staples, paper clips or metal fasteners. No packing materials. |
| MISCELLANEOUS | Automotive batteries & used motor oil. Computers & accessories & electronic devices. | No building or roofing materials, carpeting, bulk waste, asbestos waste, furniture, propane or fuel tanks, Styrofoam, medical waste or syringes. |
| SCRAP METAL | Aluminum, iron, barbecue grills, clean automotive parts, cast iron sinks, lawn mowers, etc. | Nonmetallic parts must be remove and any fluids drained. |

Construction debris, and furniture can be disposed of for a fee at the County Waste Transfer Station in South Troy at 83 Water Street. (518) 266-8900

* Garbage and non-recyclable trash must be in a Town of Brunswick Bag. The bags can be purchased at the Town Office Monday through Friday and at the Recycling Center on Saturdays or at Center Brunswick or Tamarac Stewarts' Shops.

** Purchase a tag and schedule a pickup at the Town Clerks Office Monday-Friday.
