**NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW  
SUBJECT TO PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that at a regularly scheduled meeting held on December 9, 2021, the Town Board, Town of Brunswick, New York, duly adopted Local Law No. 4 of the Year 2021 entitled "AA LOCAL LAW TO OPT OUT OF ALLOWING ON-SITE CONSUMPTION SITES AS AUTHORIZED UNDER CANNABIS LAW, ARTICLE 4", subject to a permissive referendum in accordance with New York State Cannabis Law, Section 131, and Municipal Home Rule Law, Section 24. The purpose and effect of the said Local Law is for the Town of Brunswick to opt out of allowing on-site cannabis consumption sites to be located within the Town of Brunswick, which would otherwise be allowed under the Cannabis Law, Article 4.

The said Local Law shall not take effect until forty-five (45) days after the date of its adoption; nor until approved by the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the Town of Brunswick voting on a proposition for its approval at referendum, if within forty-five (45) days after its adoption there be filed with the Town Clerk of the Town of Brunswick, a petition protesting against such Local Law, signed and authenticated as required under Municipal Home Rule Law, Section 24, by qualified electors of the Town of Brunswick, registered to vote therein at the last preceding general election, in number equal to at least ten per centum (10%) of the total number of votes cast for governor at the last gubernatorial election in the Town of Brunswick.
