| <u>Item</u> | <u>Fee</u> | <u>Action</u> |

| Garbage / Trash | \$2 (Sm.) \$3 (Lg) per Bag | Purchase TOB trash bag* |
| Small Appliances | \$5 Each | Deliver to center |
| Large Appliances | \$15 Each | Deliver to center |
| Large Appliances P/U | \$25 Each | Curbside pickup** |
| Propane Tanks (sm) | \$5 Each | Deliver to center |
| Car Tires (without rims) | \$8 Each | Deliver to center |

* Garbage and non-recyclable trash must be in a Town of Brunswick bag. The disposal fee is the price of the bag. Purchase bags at the Town Office Monday through Friday, at the Recycling Center on Saturdays and at the Center Brunswick or Tamarac Stewart's Shops.

** Purchase a tag and schedule a pickup at the Town Clerk's Office Monday - Friday (8am- 4pm).

Please note: Single-Stream Recycling now allows glass, plastic & light metal to be combined. Separating is not required.

|  Item |  Acceptable |  Unacceptable |

| Glass | Clear, green & amber glass from bottles & jars. Rinse clean & remove caps & lids. Fluorescent & CFL bulbs. | No window glass, auto glass, glass ovenware, ceramic dishware & cookware, Pyrex, clay pots, ornaments or crystal. |
| Plastic | Any plastic container that does not break when crushed. Any plastics with the recycling logo & the numbers 1, 2, or 3. | No Styrofoam, pool liners or articles without the recycle logo. No pesticide, herbicide, solvent, oil or paint containers. |
| Metal*** | Aluminum, steel and tin food or beverage containers. Rinse clean and, if possible, flatten. | No aerosol cans or containers having toxic residues such as chemicals, pesticides, herbicides, oil, gas or paint. No pie plates. |
| Papers & Corrugated Cardboard | Catalogs, newspapers, magazines, junk mail, paper bags and books. (must be clean). Pizza boxes. | No soiled paper such as that used for painting or animal waste. Remove wire bindings, staples, paper clips or metal fasteners. No packing materials. |
| Miscellaneous | Automotive batteries & used motor oil. Computers & accessories (excluding monitors) & electronic devices | No building or roofing materials, carpeting, bulk waste, asbestos waste, furniture, fuel tanks, medical waste or syringes. |

***An on-site roll off container is available for large metal items. Remove non-metallic parts & drain any fluids.
