


WATER SERVICE INTERRUPTION NOTICE

There will be a water service interruption on September 30, 2020 lasting approximately 8 hours starting at 9:00 AM in the morning to facilitate the installation of a new valve and repair of the water main at the intersection of The Crossways and Pinewoods Avenue. Service will be disrupted to homes along Pinewoods Avenue from 209 Pinewoods to 244 Pinewoods. This include the side streets, Patton Road, Cole Lane and Fairfield Road.



For those home effected by the water interruption the Water Department advises you to boil your water before using. The Boil Water Advisory will last until Friday October 2, 2020.

The Water Department of the Town of Brunswick apologizes for any inconvenience this may cause our customers. Please set aside water for drinking and flushing your facilities as required.

There will also be the potential for the water to be discolored from disturbed iron sediments in the water line. Please check your water before doing laundry for discoloration. Flush your water pipes either through a hose spigot or your bathtub faucet.

If you should experience reduced water pressure in your water faucets after water service has been restored, check all faucets by removing the water saver and protective screen on the faucet and rinse out the line, reinstall the water saver and screen after the line has be run for a few minutes. Sediment caught in the screen is the most common cause for reduced water pressure in your home.
